TELESCOPE INSTRUCTIONS

- Never look at sun through the telescope.
- · Rest the telescope on your arm with the EZ -finder up.
- · Hold the base with your other hand.
- The hand slot on the base is for aligning the telescope—do not carry solely by the hand slot.
- Telescope must be secured in a seat to prevent misalignment.
- · Place the telescope in a seat with a functional seatbelt.
- Drape the shoulder strap over the telescope column and the lap belt over the base.
- · Never transport in a trunk or truck bed. It can cause damage or it will break.




TELESCOPE CARE

- · Keep all covers on when not in use.
- Do not reach into the telescope or touch any lenses.
- · Always use on a stable surface.
- Don not get the telescope wet; keep it dry.
